## Special Olympian loses gold medals

HAMILTON (CP) - A young woman who won three gold medals at last month's Special Olympics is broken-hearted and angry today after a thief broke into her home and stole the medals.

The robber also stole a goodluck anklet given to Alanna Henwood by her swimming coach and a commemorative

U.S. silver dollar.

The 19-year-old international champion broke her own Canadian records earlier this month at the 1995 Special Olympics World Games in New Haven, Conn., winning gold medals for the 50-metre freestyle, 50-metre backstroke and 100-metre backstroke.
