Hot dog sale starts Torch Run fundraisers

Weyburn law enforcement officers will raise funds for the Special Olympics Torch Run with special events over the next three weeks.

Other fundraisers include a joint Special O/Weyburn Comprehensive SADD (Students Against Drunk Driving) car wash and a pancake breakfast. Also, a couple of local gas stations have offered to donate one cent for every litre of gas sold on certain days.
